The Georgia Standards of Excellence (GSE) offers college and career readiness for ALL students; however, the Dawson County Gifted Education Program offers opportunities for acceleration and differentiation. The elementary schools utilize advanced content & cluster delivery models, while the middle & junior high schools are able to provide the advanced content model in most academic content areas and at all grade levels.

Advanced placement courses, internships, and dual enrollment with post-secondary institutions are delivery models utilized by Dawson County High School to effectively meet the needs of high school gifted and talented students.

Gifted Models Offered at Dawson County Schools

Cluster Grouping Model

Gifted students learn in a small group setting within the traditional classroom.

Advanced Content Model

A rigorous and accelerated curriculum is used for the gifted and advanced learners in their own classroom.

Advanced Placement Model

Students have the opportunity to take college-level courses in high school and earn advanced placement &/or credit in college by obtaining a qualifying score on the AP exam.

Dual Enrollment

High school students partner with a post-secondary institution to take college-level courses for dual credit.
