
What if someone at school is infected with COVID-19?









School administration will notify the Director of Youth Health Services and School Safety Officer.



Positive COVID-19 case reported to school administration.




The Director of Youth Health Services and School Safety Officer will conduct an in-school investigation, gather facts, and additional information.



Information will be shared with the Department of Public Health.



Parents/Guardians of students who are identified by the Department of Public Health as needing to quarantine will be notified by phone and letter.



The Department of Public Health will determine quarantine and isolation periods for impacted students and staff.



Parents of impacted student may receive a follow-up phone call from the Department of Public Health.
